

AaCarb Carbomer 0.2% Eye Gel

For Long Lasting Relief from Dry Eyes

Lubricating and Cooling Sterile eye gel

Instructions for use

10g

AaCarb moisturizing eye gel is a long-lasting, gentle and comfortable night time gel for dry and tired eyes providing overnight hydration therapy for relief from ocular discomfort caused by dryness. AaCarb moisturizing eye gel protects and moistens eyes to remove the discomfort and irritation throughout the night.

1. CONTENTS:

AaCarb moisturizing eye gel contains carbomer 0.2% with preservative cetrimide, in buffered isotonic system with neutral pH.

Other Ingredients: Edetate Disodium, Mannitol, Hypromellose. May contain Sodium Hydroxide to adjust pH.

2. CONTRAINDICATIONS:

Hypersensitivity to Carbomer or to any of the ingredients listed above.

3. INTENDED USE:

AaCarb moisturizing eye gel is a specially formulated long-lasting, gentle and comfortable night time gel for dry and tired eyes providing overnight hydration therapy for relief from ocular discomfort caused by dryness. AaCarb moisturizing eye protects and moistens eyes to remove the discomfort and irritation throughout the night.

4. DIRECTION FOR USE:

Place 1 or 2 drops in the eye(s) as needed.



Gel the AaCarb moisturizing eye gel and a minor.

- Wash your hands.
- Take the tube and peel off the tamper evident snap collar.
- Open the cap, hold the tube, pointing down, between you thumb and middle finger.
- Tilt your head back. Pull down your eyelid with a clean finger, until there is a 'pocket' between the eyelid and your eye. The drop will go in here (picture 1).
- Bring the tube tip close to the eye. Use the mirror if it helps.
- Don't touch your eye or eyelid, surrounding areas or other surface with the tube tip. It could contaminate the product left in the tube.
- Gentle press on the base of the tube to release one drop of AaCarb moisturizing eye gel at a time.
- Don't squeeze the tube, it is designed so that just a gentle press on the bottom is needed. (picture 2)
- If you use the gel in both eyes, repeat the steps for your other eye.
- Put the cap back on firmly immediately after use. If a drop misses your eye, try again.
- White particles may appear on eye lashes post administration of product if the product oozes out of the eyes. Wipe area around eye with clean cloth soaked in lukewarm water after administration of AaCarb if needed.

5. PRECAUTIONS:

- Do not use if allergic to any of the ingredients.
- The tube tip remains sterile till the tube is opened.
- To avoid contamination or possible eye injury, do not touch tube tip to any surface and avoid contact with eye.
- Close the cap tightly immediately after use.
- Once opened, discard any unused content after 1 month.
- Do not use after expiry date indicated on the carton & tube.
- Do not use if package is damaged or the tamper evident seal is broken.
- Discard the product content if it becomes cloudy or brown.
- Store in a dry, dark & well-ventilated place at a temperature not exceed 25°C.
- Allow 30 minutes between the administration of other eye products.
- Remove contact lenses before use.
- Consult your doctor, pharmacist or optician before you use AaCarb moisturizing eye gel if:
 - You are pregnant or breast feeding.
 - You are suffering from any other eye disease or disorder.
 - You are using any other medicines in your eyes

6. SIDE EFFECTS:

Common: Eye irritation (Including burning and discomfort), eye pain, eye pruritus and / or visual disturbance.

Blurring of vision immediately after use. Do not operate machinery, use electric tools or drive a car until clear vision is restored.

In the event that you experience side effects not mentioned in this leaflet, or if there is prolonged irritation or severe visual disturbance or any change in your general health, consult your doctor immediately.

7. EXPECTED GROUP OF PATIENTS FOR OCULAR LUBRICATING & COMFORT SOLUTION:

Children above the age of 5 years, adult & geriatrics population, who are affected by dry eye (such as soreness, burning, irritation or dryness) or dry eye syndrome.

Dry eyes syndrome, also known as chronic dry eye is characterized by reduced ability to form tears or reduction in the quality of those tears.

WARNING: If you experience any problems with this product please discuss with your pharmacist, GP or eye care specialist. Do not soak or disinfect your lenses in AaCarb moisturizing eye gel.

8. INSTRUCTION FOR DISPOSAL:

The device should be disposed as per prevailing regulations where the device is used.

9. HOW SUPPLIED:

AaCarb Moisturizing eye gel is supplied in 10g pack size in a lami tube.

Note: This leaflet is specific to AaCarb Moisturizing Eye gel.
