

Lubricant Eye Drops Carmellose 0.5% **Eye Drops**



(Carboxy Methyl Cellulose Eye Drops)

Instructions for Use

It is important to read this leaflet carefully before using Aqualube eye drops. The information provided summarises the important points about the product but if you have any further questions then please ask your doctor, pharmacist or optician.

1. Dosage form:

Ophthalmic solution.

2. Composition:

Each ml contains:

Stabilised Ocychloro Complex (As Preservative)...............................0.005%w/v Water for Injection B.P.....q.s.

Description:

Aqualube Eye Drops is a sterile eye lubricant which provides immediate relief plus protection from dryness and irritation of eye.

3. Indication:

- For temporary relief from burning irritation and discomfort due to dryness of the eye.
- Discomfort due to exposure to wind or sun.
- Used as protecting agent against further irritation.
- Restores moisture of your eyes.

4. Direction for Use:

Before opening a new bottle of Aqualube eye drop, please check the safety seal of the bottle is unbroken.

- Wash and dry your hands well before use. 1.
- 2. Rotate the cap anticlock wise to break the seal.
- 3. Remove the cap.
- Tilt your head back and look up. 4.
- Gently pull down the lower lid of the eye to form a small pocket between your eyelid and your eye.
- Hold the bottle between you thumb and middle finger of your other hand and apply moderate pressure to the bottle to release one to two drops of Aqualube eye drop into the pocket.
- Don't touch your eye or eyelid, surrounding areas or other surfaces with the dropper. It could infect the drops left in the bottle.
- 8. Blink your eye a few times.
- 9. If you think that you have missed the eye, then insert another drop.
- 10. Carefully wipe away any excess product around the eyelid.
- 11. Repeat the process for the other eye, if required.
- 12. Put the bottle cap back on firmly immediately after use. If you are unsure about how to use AcquLube eye drop consult your doctor, pharmacist or optician.

5. Dosage & Administration:

Instill 1 to 2 drops in the affected eye(s) as directed.

6. Contraindications:

Hypersensitivity to any ingredients of this eye drops.

7. Warning & Precautions:

- Keep out of the reach and sight of children.
- For external ophthalmic use only. Not for Injection.
- Do not use if the safety seal on the cap of the bottle is broken before first use.
- Do not use if you are allergic to any of the ingredients.
- To avoid contamination, do not touch the tip of the bottle with your eye or any surface or dip the nozzle in any liquid.
- Replace cap after using.
- Do not share this product with any other person.
- Do not use after the expiry date shown on the carton or printed on the bottle label.

- Leave at least 30 minutes between administrations of any other ophthalmic
- Do not use if solution changes color or becomes cloudy.
- Do not swallow.
- Do not store above 25°C.
- Discard the bottle 28 days after first opening. However contents may not last for 28 days depending upon the frequency of use.
- Do not attempt to refill the bottle.
- If you experience eye pain, change in vision, continued redness or irritation of the eyes, if condition worsens or persist for more than 72 hours, discontinue use and consult a doctor.
- Consult your doctor, pharmacist or optician before you use this product if you are pregnant or breast-feeding.
- Incase of accidental ingestion, seek professional assistance or consult your
- Dispose of the used bottle according to your local waste management regulations.

Pregnancy and Lactation:

Safe use during pregnancy and lactation has not been established.

Effects on ability to drive and use machines:

Aqualube Eye Drops may temporarily cause blurred vision right after being placed in the eye(s). Do not drive, use machinery, or do any activity that requires clear vision until you are sure you can perform such activities safely.

Adverse Effects:

Aqualube Eye Drops rarely causes side effects or an allergic reaction. Vision may be temporarily blurred when this product is first used. Minor burning, stinging or irritation may temporarily occur.

Over dosage:

There is no experience of overdose by the ophthalmic route. Overdose is unlikely to occur via the recommended route of administration.

Storage:

Store below 25°C. Protect from light. Do not freeze.

Directions:

Use Aqualube Eye Drops within 28 days after first opening of the vial.

Presentation:

Aqualube Eye Drops are available in 10ml plastic vial pack.
